

## **Contribution of Zia Uddin, PhD in the Continuing Medical Education of the Physicians**

Since **1976**, I have presented >30 times recent advances in clinical chemistry laboratory tests at the following meetings of Ascension Macomb-Oakland Hospital, Warren, MI.

- a. Division of Medicine
- b. Division of Obstetrics & Gynecology
- c. Division of Surgery

Some of these laboratory tests (e.g., hemoglobin A1c, Cholesterol fractionation in HDL, LDL & VLDL, triple test for Down's syndrome, peak and trough values of aminoglycosides, etc.) were instituted by me for the first time in the southeastern Michigan hospital. I introduced Vitamin D3 assay for the first time in 2008.

My most recent presentation (2019) was at the Division of Medicine, Ascension MacombOakland Hospital, Warren, MI. I spoke on the advent of Telehealth and the training of medical residents via the Internet.

Since **1976**, I have provided >1000 times consultative services (oral/written) to the physicians concerning the interpretation of the laboratory tests. I also recommended additional tests to facilitate them in the diagnosis of disease.

In **2020**, I was requested by the Chief Medical Officer, Ascension Macomb-Oakland Hospital, Warren, MI to provide literature on Telehealth. I had two meetings with the senior attending

physicians and provided to them the most recent articles on Telehealth. Later on I was requested to submit to them a written document on Telehealth, which I also did.

We were the first to educate the physicians in Michigan about the “Telemedicine and Artificial Intelligence in Healthcare.”
